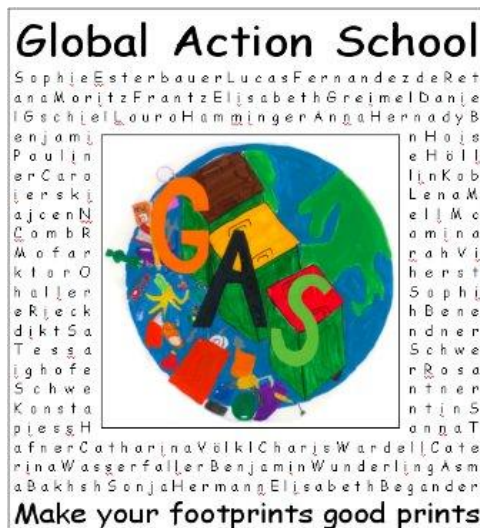
General Information:

1. SCHOOLS SHOULD SEND THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Full name and (optionally) the address of the school (+ country); website address
- Interesting photos of (ideally) Ts and Ss involved in the project and somehow connected with the project (max. 100kb) with a short description (who? what? where?)
- Contact details to the coordinator at school (teacher) and (optionally) to the most active students (ideally they should send their photos as well, but let us leave it up to them).
- A presentation (in WORD document) 100 words lead and up to 400 words description pdf

- **IMPORTANT!:** All photos should be sent separately (apart from the ones in the presentation pdf)

2. LEAD:

1/ What is your school like? (i.e. Tell us about 3 important points regarding your school)

- Word limit: up to 100 words (lead) – this will be visible on the website.
- Make sure this part is an interesting, catchy introduction as this will be the first thing other schools will see.

3. PRESENTATION - PDF Document:

- up to 400 words (main text) – this would be included in the pdf document
- up to 2 pages including pictures (ready made pdf)

In this part schools should answer the following questions. to make sure that all the descriptions contain the same, useful for networking, information. If the school would like to include anything else, then there is no problem as long as they do not write more than 400 words.

1/ Why did your school decide to take part in GAS2Communities project?

2/ Which topic does your school focus on within the project? Why did you choose this topic and what have you done in the project so far about this topic? What was its biggest success?

3/ Who is your (future) local partner? How is the partner involved?

4/ Why have you chosen this thematic pool?
